#### From the Desk of Pastor Richard

When I think about prayer, I immediately picture Jesus. The reason for this is because Jesus spent a lot of time praying. He often went off on his own to pray, but he also took time to pray with his followers. Jesus even gave us the Lord's Prayer as a model to teach us how to pray. For these reasons, whenever we talk about prayer, we tend to begin and end with Jesus.

But Jesus isn't the only one Biblical figure who prayed; many others prayed some incredible prayers.

One such prayer came from Moses and can be found in Exodus 15. Here's a portion of that prayer:

Then Moses and the Israelites sang this song to the LORD:

I will sing to the LORD, for he has t riumphed gloriously; horse and rider he has thrown into the sea. The LORD is my strength and my might, and he has become my salvation; this is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him. The LORD is a warrior; the LORD is his name.

"Pharaoh's chariots and his army he cast into the sea; his picked officers were sunk in the Red Sea.
The floods covered them; they went down into the depths like a stone.
Your right hand, O LORD, glorious in power

your right hand, O LORD, shattered the enemy. In the greatness of your majesty you overthrew your adversaries;
you sent out your fury, it consumed them
like stubble.

At the blast of your nostrils the waters piled up, the floods stood up in a heap; the deeps congealed in the heart of the sea. The enemy said, 'I will pursue, I will overtake, I will divide the spoil, my desire shall have its fill of them.

I will draw my sword, my hand shall destroy them.'

You blew with your wind, the sea covered them; they sank like lead in the mighty waters.

"Who is like you, O LORD, among the gods? Who is like you, majestic in holiness, awesome in splendor, doing wonders? -Exodus 15:1-11 NRSV

Because prayer is a conversation with God, it can take many forms. In the case of Exodus 15, prayer takes the form of a poem. This particular poem is a prayer of celebration. Moses and the Israelites sang it together to rejoice in the Good News that God had guided them from slavery in Egypt to freedom and new life.


God leads us to new life through the cross of Christ Jesus. We, too, can pray in celebration at the Good News of what God has done for us through Jesus!
