# From the Desk of Pastor Richard

If someone asked you, "What's a Christian?" I suspect you would answer by saying something to the effect that a Christian is a follower of Jesus Christ. But, how would you respond if someone asked you, "Why are you a Christian?" This question can be challenging because it requires us to think about what we believe about Jesus and why. It can also leave us feeling unprepared and unqualified to answer effectively. Thankfully, 1 Peter gives us some tips to help us answer this question. These tips are as follows:

#### Tip one - Remember that it's all about Jesus.

Being a Christian is less about us and more about Jesus. 1 Peter reminds us of this fact when it says, "But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord." (1 Peter 3.15a) The question, "Why are you a Christian?" becomes much easier to answer when we remember that being a Christian is about who Jesus is and what He has done.

#### Tip two - Preparation is a good thing.

Whenever I make dinner, it goes much more quickly and smoothly if I've prepared all the ingredients in advance; nothing slows me down like a failure to prepare. Similarly, 1 Peter 3 tells us to, "Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have." (1 Peter 3.15b) The best way to prepare to tell someone why you are a Christian is to first wrestle with this question personally.

#### Tip three - Mind your manners.

When I was growing up, my dad stressed the importance of treating others with respect. He made it clear that words like 'please' and 'thank-you' were not optional. Nothing would get me into trouble faster than failing to be respectful of others. 1 Peter 3 shares a similar message when it instructs us to tell others why we follow Jesus "with gentleness and respect." (1 Peter 3.15c) This verse is a good reminder that it's not just about what we say but how we say it.

#### Tip four - Relax and be yourself.

Remember that telling others why you are a Christian is as easy as sharing how God is active and working in your life through Jesus.

May the Lord bless and keep you as you share the reason for the hope you have!


