From the Desk of Pastor Richard

I recently noted that many of the Psalms pull heavily on creation imagery. Psalm 104, which refers to the six days of creation, is a perfect example of this fact. Take a moment to reflect on verses 2-4. As you do so, pay particular attention to the description of God.

The LORD wraps himself in light as if it were a robe.

He spreads out the heavens like a tent.

He builds his palace high in the heavens.

He makes the clouds serve as his chariot.

He rides on the wings of the wind.

He makes the winds serve as his messengers.

He makes flashes of lightning serve him. (NIRV)

One of my favorite portions of this Psalm comes later, in verses 24-25, where it describes the numerous things God created, including the oceans and all living creatures. As you read this portion of the Psalm, take a moment to think about all God has created and how God's creative activity impacts you every day.

LORD, you have made so many things!

How wise you were when you made all of them!

The earth is full of your creatures.

Look at the ocean, so big and wide!

It is filled with more creatures than people can count.

It is filled with living things, from the largest to the smallest. (NIRV)

Psalm 104 concludes with the following words for us to ponder:

I will praise the Lord (NIRV)

May you be blessed as you praise the Lord of creation!
